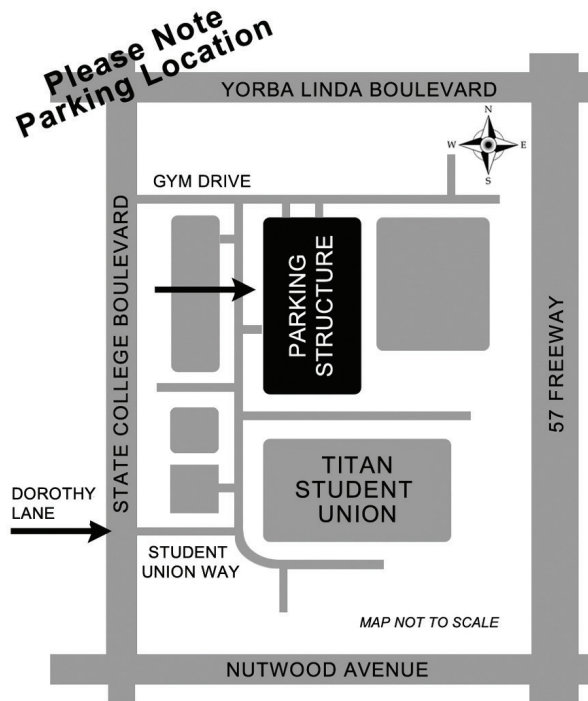

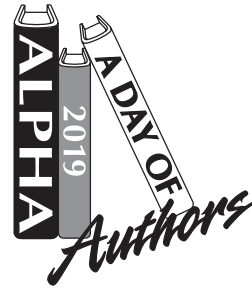

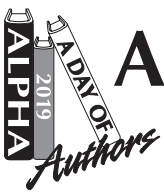

9:15–10:05am James Rollins - Featured Speaker

James Rollins, the #1 *New York Times* bestselling author, left his veterinary practice to write action-adventure, thriller, and mystery novels. The 14 novels in the Sigma Force series unveil unseen worlds, scientific breakthroughs, and historical secrets with stunning insight. "...I'm playing with the future's edge, looking at technology and...how technological change might pose a threat or challenge our moral values," Rollins explains. *The Demon Crown* is "Bone-chilling." (*Publishers Weekly*) In *Crucible*, the latest novel in the series, Sigma Force wrestles with the spiritual mysteries of mankind with cutting edge science, historical mystery, and pulse-pounding action.

Robin Benway

Robin Benway is the bestselling author of young adult novels including *Emmy & Oliver*, *Going Rogue*, and *Audrey, Wait!* Winner of the 2017 National Book Award for Young People's Literature, *Far From the Tree*—a beautiful interweaving story of three very different teenagers connected by blood—explores the meaning of family in all its forms, how to find it, how to keep it, and how to love it. Named a best book of the year by *The New York Times*, the *LA Times*, and *The Boston Globe*.

Nick Dybek

Nick Dybek's *When Captain Flint Was Still a Good Man*, is a "Powerful first novel [exploring] loyalty and morality within a crumbling family." (*The Boston Globe*) When a son's suspicions deepen, his moral compass shatters. *The Verdun Affair* follows a lonely young man, a beautiful widow, and the amnesiac soldier whose puzzling case binds them together as it tears them apart invoking a saga of secrets, lies, love, and betrayal. *Verdun* is "...a complex tale of memory, choice, and sacrifices sometimes made by doing the right thing." Jessica Knoll

Jessica Knoll's wildly successful literary debut, *Luckiest Girl Alive*, nominated for the Edgar Award for Best First Novel by an American Author, is "completely enthralling... devilishly dark and fun." (*Publishers Weekly*) Knoll's latest novel, *The Favorite Sister*, explores the duplicity of family ties and friendship in this razor-sharp, darkly comic thriller. When five hyper-successful women agree to appear on a reality series set in New York called *Goal Diggers*, the producers never expect the season will end in murder.

Ralph Pezzullo

Ralph Pezzullo—After collaborating with a covert US intelligence operative on the best-seller, *Jawbreaker*, Pezzullo was contacted by DEA and FBI agents, police detectives, Special Forces soldiers, and Navy SEALs who had interesting stories to tell. His latest, *Ghost: My Thirty Years as an FBI Undercover Agent* with Michael McGowan, is "a thrilling insider's view of an undercover FBI agent." (*Publisher's Weekly*) His books have been published in over twenty languages and include, *Inside SEAL Team Six* and *Hunt the Viper* (with Don Mann), *Zero Footprint*, and *Full Battle Rattle*.

Ivy Pochoda

Ivy Pochoda is the author of the critically acclaimed novels *Wonder Valley* and *Visitation Street*. A mystery, *Visitation Street* is set against the rough-hewn backdrop of the New York waterfront. *Wonder Valley*, a 2017 NPR Best Book and finalist for the *LA Times* Book Prize follows characters on the edge, whose lives intersect in surprising and at times terrifying ways as a result of their poor decisions. "Destined to be a classic L.A. novel."—Michael Connelly. "Unexpected and pitch-perfect." (*Los Angeles Times*)

Tatjana Soli

Tatjana Soli (*The Lotus Eaters*) returns to *A Day of Authors* with her new novel, *The Removes*, "...a narrative of the American West centered on women,...remaking the classic Western myth." (*The San Francisco Chronicle*) The lives of Gen. George Custer, his wife, Libbie, and a 15-year-old Kansas farmer's daughter converge in this historical novel about the American frontier.
