St. Jude's Neighborhood Health Center "Healthy Beginnings" Program: Provides clothing, blankets, diapers and age appropriate books to needy infants

McKinney-Vento Toiletry & Birthday Book Program:

Scholarships granted to participate in a program that promotes physical, cognitive & social well-being of at-risk youth and/or those with special needs through a partnership with horses.



Fullerton Police Explorer Program Post 204:

Scholarships provided for worthy students to attend an academy for high school students interested in pursuing a career in law enforcement.



Operation School Bell:

ALPHA joins with The Assistance League of Fullerton in giving needy, local children backpacks filled with clothing, shoes, reading books and school supplies.



Santa's Closet:

Together with Pathways of Hope & Fullerton School District Parent/Teacher Association, provide families in need Holiday gift cards to be used in the Assistance League Thrift Shop.

Purchase of plus toys designed to resemble the Police Departments Canine comfort dog "Nubbin." The toys are given to local children during traumatic events.
